You will receive an Agenda which will detail the schedule for the meeting that is expected to run less than 4 hours. It will start at 8:30 AM on June 27, 2020 with a short 30 minute Meet and Greet session followed at 9 AM by the Convention sessions.

There will be presentations at the convention by the District's Male & Female ACE and Youth of the Year winners. There will be reports by the District Officers, by National Executive Vice President (EVP) Tracey Edwards, and by the District Charitable Foundation. There will be an election of Officers and Division Directors. If you would like to run for one of the offices that will be up for election please see the Suggested Candidate form which will be provided in addition to this form.
